Areas of Policy Implementation

- 1. **Website**: The college website serves as a crucial interface for students, faculty, guardians, and the public. It includes comprehensive information about the college's history, courses, faculty details, upcoming events, and activities of committees, clubs, and cells.
- 2. **Student Admissions**: Admission to undergraduate courses is conducted online as per the guidelines of the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal. The college utilizes a private vendor's services to maintain an accessible and error-free admission portal.
- 3. **Library**: Efforts are made to maintain and preserve the college library's collection through e-cataloguing and updated software for efficient management.
- 4. **Alumni Relations**: Regular meetings with alumni are held, and the registration process is conducted according to the Society Registration Act.
- 5. **Finance and Accounts**: All financial transactions and staff salaries are managed through the West Bengal Integrated Finance Management System (WBIFMS), adhering to government regulations.
- 6. **Examinations**: Internal marks, attendance records, and practical examination results are uploaded to the university portal in compliance with university guidelines.
